I, the undersigned, request that eHealth Privacy Service globally mask my profile in the Pharmaceutical Information Program (PIP), the Picture Archiving and Communication System (PACS) and/or the Saskatchewan Laboratory Results Repository (SLRR) as indicated below. I accept all risk associated with the masking of these profiles including, but not limited to, any delay which may be experienced in obtaining treatment or any decisions which may be made by health professionals based on not having access to my profiles in PIP, PACS and/or SLRR.

I understand that I may not have a record in the PACS or SLRR applications at this time but global masking will apply to any future records.
